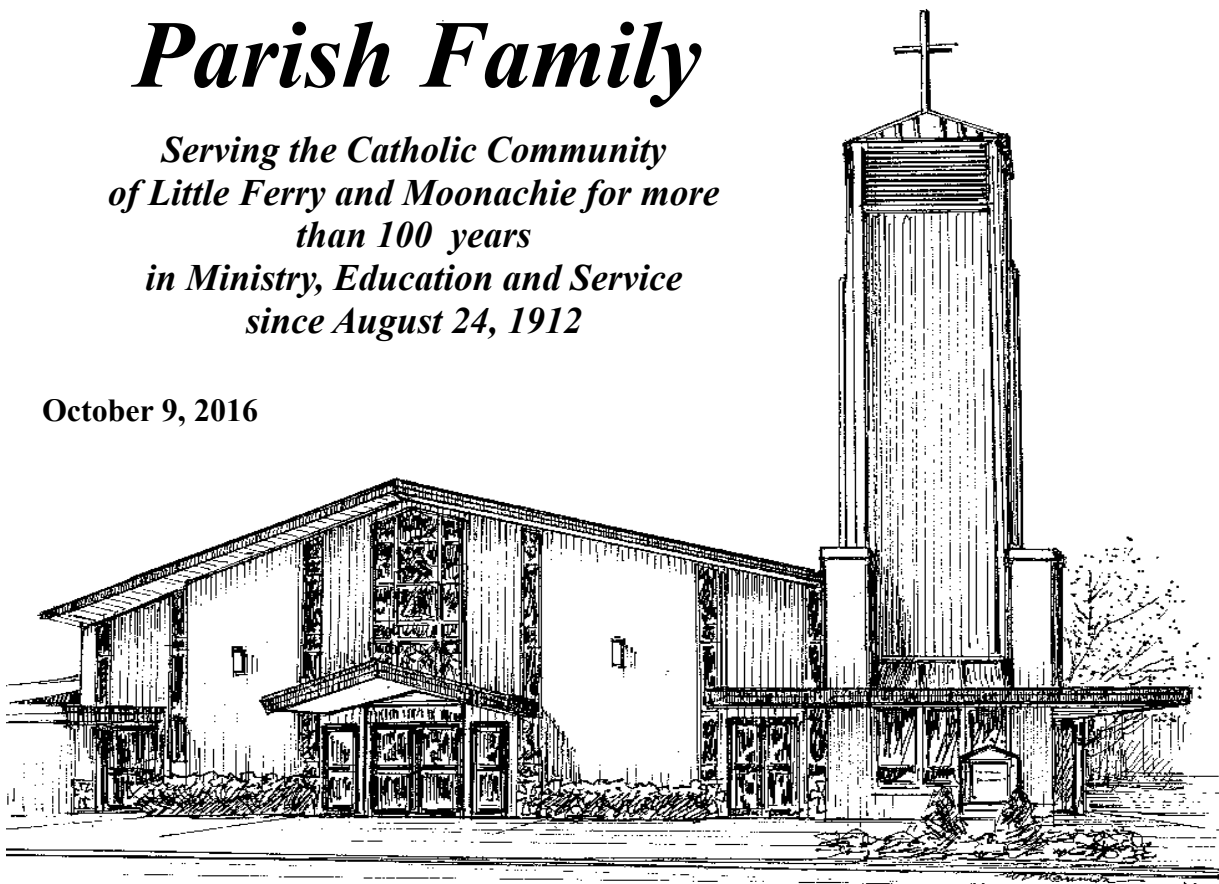

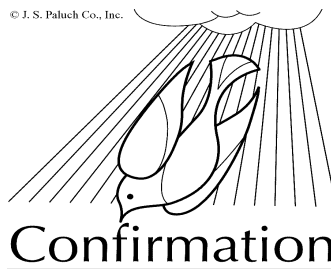

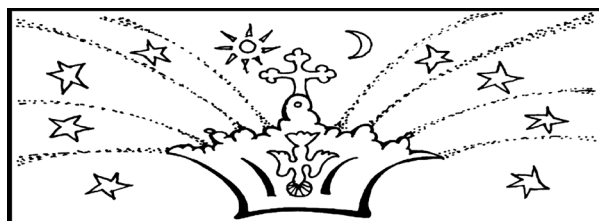

MASS

Mass is the celebration of the Eucharist in which bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. It has two major parts: Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Mass is the best expression of the Church's worship of God. Participants at each celebration of Mass include: the celebrant (priest), liturgical minister(s), eg., reader, Minister of the Eucharist, altar servers, choir and the assembly. The role of those in each group is different but equally important.

Altar—the table in church whereon the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is celebrated and on which the sacrifice of the cross is made present in the Eucharist.

Amen— " yes, I believe"

Consecration - the part of Mass in which bread and wine become Jesus' Body and Blood through the power of the Holy Spirit and the words and actions of the celebrant.

Lectionary—official liturgical book that contains the Scripture readings for Mass. At Sunday liturgy, the readings from the lectionary include: a reading from the Old Testament, a psalm response (from Old Testament) to that reading, a reading from the New Testament and a reading from one of the four gospels.

Liturgy of the Eucharist—One of the two major parts of the Mass that is made up of the Preparation of the Gifts, the Eucharistic Prayer, and the Communion Rite.

Liturgy of the Word—One of the two major parts of the Mass that is made up of readings from the Old and New Testaments, Responsorial Psalm, Gospel, Homily, Creed and Prayer of the Faithful.

Vestments worn by priest:

Alb -a full length white garment

Chasuble— outer liturgical vestment (covering the alb); its color changes according to feast or liturgical season.

Stole— liturgical vestment in the form of a long narrow strip of cloth worn around the neck. The color is determined by feast or liturgical season. The stole is worn at all sacramental celebrations.
