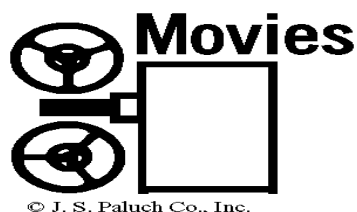
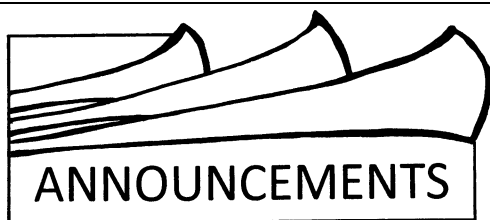
Valentine Tea Party

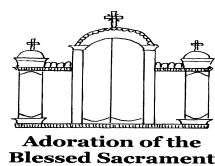
Prayer Shawl Ministry
